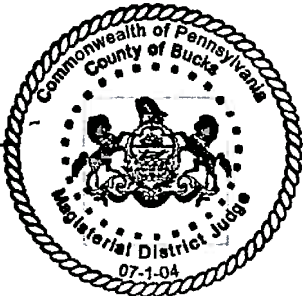

**Probable Cause belief is based upon the following facts and circumstances:**

**AFFIANT INTRODUCTION**

Your Honor, your Affiants are Detective Emilyann Maialetti of the Bristol Township Police Department and Detectives Eric Landamia and William Mooney of the Bucks County District Attorney's Office.

Your Affiant, Detective Emilyann Maialetti, Badge #179, has been a sworn member of the Bristol Township Police Department since December of 2019 and is currently assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division. As a patrolman with the Bristol Township Police Department Affiant Maialetti was a Field Training Officer. Affiant Maialetti received training in crash reconstruction and is on the Bristol Township Police Traffic Safety Unit. During your Affiant's time with Bristol Township, she has made numerous arrests for various criminal violations. Affiant Maialetti is a certified Police Officer in the state of Pennsylvania and is authorized to conduct criminal investigations and make arrests in all criminal cases.

Your Affiant, Detective Eric Landamia, Badge #9924, of the Bucks County District Attorney's Office, Bucks County, PA, has been duly sworn/appointed/employed as a police officer in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania since 2001. Your Affiant is certified as a Police Officer in Pennsylvania and is authorized to conduct criminal investigations and make arrests in all criminal cases. Your Affiant has investigated numerous cases involving the exploitation of children. Your Affiant is currently an affiliate member of the Pennsylvania Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force (PA ICAC). PA ICAC is specially trained and investigates crimes against children. Additionally, your Affiant is a Task Force Officer with the Federal Bureau of Investigation Violent Crimes Against Children (VCAC) division. Specifically, your Affiant is assigned to investigate crimes involving the online sexual exploitation of children.

Your Affiant, Detective William Mooney, Badge #9943, of the Bucks County District Attorney's Office, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, has been duly sworn/appointed/employed as a police officer

in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and is authorized to conduct criminal investigations and make all arrests in all criminal cases within Bucks County, Pennsylvania. Your Affiant has been employed as a police officer in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania since March of 2001.

The facts set forth in this affidavit are based upon your Affiants' personal knowledge; knowledge obtained from other individuals/entities during our participation in this investigation, including other law enforcement personnel; review of documents and records related to this investigation; communications with others who have personal knowledge of the events and circumstances described herein; as well as information gained through our training and experience.

Because this affidavit is being submitted for the limited purpose of establishing probable cause, your Affiants have not included every aspect, fact, or detail of this investigation.

**BACKGROUND**

The names and identities of the victims are known to your Affiants. To protect the integrity of the investigation as well as the identity of the victims in this Affidavit of Probable Cause, the victims will be referred to as follows:

CV-1 (Commonwealth Victim #1) – CV-1 is a 24-year-old female whose identity is known to law enforcement. CV-1 resided in New Jersey at the time of her victimization.

CV-2 (Commonwealth Victim #2) – CV-2 is a 29-year-old female whose identity is known to law enforcement. CV-2 resided in New Jersey at the time of her victimization.

CV-3 (Commonwealth Victim #3) – CV-3 is a 30-year-old female whose identity is known to law enforcement. CV-3 resided in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania at the time of her victimization.

CV-4 (Commonwealth Victim #4) – CV-4 is a ??-year-old female whose identity is known to law enforcement. CV-4 resided in Bethlehem, Pennsylvania at the time of her victimization.

CV-5 (Commonwealth Victim #5) – CV-5 is an 18-year-old female whose identity is known to law enforcement. CV-5 resided in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania at the time of her victimization.

CV-6 (Commonwealth Victim #6) – CV-6 is a 17-year-old female whose identity is known to law enforcement. CV-6 resided in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania at the time of her victimization.

Andrew Gallo – Andrew Gallo, D.O.B. 04/18/1984, 40 years of age, is the accused. Gallo resides at 32 Copper Beech Lane Levittown, PA (Bristol Township, Bucks County). Gallo has resided at this residence for the duration of the events identified herein. This address is also the location of each incident involving the victims.

SugarDaddyMeet.com / SDM – SugarDaddyMeet.com is the URL for a website which offers “*a platform for generous men and attractive women looking to form honest relationships*” ([https://www.sugardaddymeet.com/about\\_us](https://www.sugardaddymeet.com/about_us)). For the purposes of this affidavit, any references to SugarDaddyMeet.com and/or the acronym SDM reference this website.

**INVESTIGATION**

**CV-1**

Through interviews with your Affiants, CV-1 reported the following: CV-1 advised she met a man, identified as Andrew Gallo, on SugarDaddyMeet.com. CV-1 stated on December 24, 2023, she met him at a restaurant in Langhorne, PA and later traveled to his residence. CV-1 stated that when they got to Gallo’s residence, it was only her, Gallo and his dog present. CV-1 reported that Gallo made her a drink in the kitchen, which she did not witness him making, as she was playing with the dog. CV-1 advised she does not drink often, so she was unsure of what type of drink he made, but described the drink as having a sugar rim. CV-1 advised she only had one

drink while at the residence and that she finished the entire drink. CV-1 stated that night, after consuming the drink, she did not sleep and was not tired. CV-1 advised your Affiants that she felt strange as she felt both energetic and calm/cool. She stated she felt that if she fell asleep her body was not going to awaken. CV-1 stated that night they engaged in sexual activity. CV-1 reported Gallo choking her a lot during their sexual encounter, to the point he was restricting her air flow and she had to tell him to stop. CV-1 left Gallo's residence the next day.

CV-1 advised your Affiants that she applied to work for a large corporate entity as a driver and had to be drug tested as part of the application process. She went for that drug test on December 28, 2023. CV-1 advised she received the results approximately two (2) weeks after the test. The results of the analysis indicated CV-1 tested positive for multiple substances, to include cocaine and methamphetamine. CV-1 advised when she got the test results, she realized why she felt the way she did the first night she met Gallo. CV-1 stated prior to realizing Gallo drugged her she met with him a few times after the incident. CV-1 stated she would bring him food to work and hang out with him at his construction sites.

CV-1 accessed and showed Affiant Maialetti the online profile for Gallo on SugarDaddyMeet.com, under username DREWSTER420. The profile had multiple pictures of Gallo, to include listing him as a forty (40) year old male from Levittown, PA.

On August 6, 2024, Affiant Maialetti obtained the drug results from CV-1's drug analysis, which showed her test results were positive for cocaine metabolite, amphetamine, methamphetamine, and marijuana metabolite. CV-1 advised your Affiants that she did not knowingly ingest any narcotics while with Andrew Gallo at his residence in Bristol Township, nor did she consent to any narcotics being provided to her surreptitiously. CV-1 reported that she felt a lack of control during the sexual encounter, being unable to stop anything Gallo wished to do, after having consumed the beverage Gallo provided to her.

CV-2

Through interviews with your Affiants, CV-2 reported the following: CV-2 advised she met a man named Andrew Gallo online at a website called SugarDaddyMeet.com. CV-2 stated that her and Gallo started talking in June of 2023 and met in person shortly after. CV-2 stated Gallo asked if she drinks and stated that he was going to make her some drinks when they met. CV-2 responded, advising Gallo that she did not drink, to which Gallo never replied. Gallo later asked CV-2 if she drank wine, which she affirmed. CV-2 stated they then set up a meeting and she went to his residence, located at 32 Copper Beech Lane, Levittown, PA, 19055.

CV-2 stated when she arrived at his residence, Gallo gave her a tour of his house, telling her that he rebuilt it after a fire. CV-2 stated he then pulled a bottle of white wine out of his refrigerator and poured her a glass. CV-2 observed that the bottle had already been opened prior to Gallo pouring her glass. CV-2 stated Gallo then told her he was going to take a shower since he just finished work. Gallo exited the bathroom approximately thirty (30) minutes later and asked CV-2 how she was feeling. CV-2 stated she said she was feeling fine, but after fifteen (15) more minutes passed, she started feeling very aroused. CV-2 stated Gallo mentioned how he bought a bunch of lingerie for his ex-girlfriend, but they broke up and she never got to wear them. CV-2 stated Gallo told her to put them on, to which she complied. CV-2 stated she felt like all her inhibitions were gone and she would have done anything. CV-2 stated she put the lingerie on and went to the bedroom. Gallo asked if she ever used sex toys, to which she replied that she had not. CV-2 stated she agreed to the use of the toys and did not say no because she felt what she described as a weird feeling, feeling very sexual. CV-2 stated they had sex for a couple hours. CV-2 advised that she has had wine before, and the feeling she was experiencing that night was unusual and not a feeling she experienced the previous times she had consumed wine. CV-2 stated she confronted Gallo and asked him if he had drugged her. Gallo told CV-2 that he forgot he had put Molly inside the bottle of wine.

CV-2 described an incident that occurred around October 2023, when Gallo took her camping at Lake Wallenpaupack. CV-2 stated that during the car ride, Gallo told her to try a new flavor of

Mountain Dew, which was in an already-opened bottle. CV-2 stated about an hour after drinking the Mountain Dew, they arrived at their camp site. CV-2 started to feel the same way she felt when she first met him, during the incident involving the wine. CV-2 stated Gallo brought lingerie and sex toys to the camp site. CV-2 stated Gallo told her to perform oral sex on him and he started recording it on his cell phone. CV-2 stated she felt, "...*high and out of it.*" CV-2 stated he tried to choke her while they were having sex placing his hand around her throat and squeezing, trying to make her pass out. CV-2 stated she tried to fight against the choking, telling Gallo she was scared to pass out and did not want to be choked. CV-2 stated Gallo responded by saying, "*That's how it works*", and that she was supposed to pass out because that's the fun in it. Gallo also told CV-2 to stop fighting it. CV-2 stated they subsequently had sex for hours in the tent, during which she felt like she did not have control of her faculties nor the ability to stop Gallo's actions.

CV-2 described an incident where she voluntarily consumed "shrooms" with the defendant, which were in a clear pill like capsule. She reported that after consuming the drug, she engaged in sexual contact with the defendant. She reported that based on how she was feeling the following day, she went to Inspira Hospital. During her visit, medical staff advised CV-2 that her test results showed methamphetamine in her system and that she was experiencing psychosis. CV-2 reported she did not sleep for four (4) days. CV-2 subsequently confronted Gallo and told him about the drug test results. Gallo responded by telling her his friend Frank must have given him the wrong drugs.

CV-3

On February 23, 2024, at approximately 7:30am, Bristol Township Police were dispatched to 32 Copper Beech Lane, Levittown, PA, 19055, for a check of the well-being. When police arrived, they contacted CV-3. Affiant Maialetti reviewed the Axon Body-Worn Camera footage from the Officers who responded to the residence. CV-3 told officers at approximately 9:46pm the previous night, February 22, 2024, she was inside the residence with Andrew Gallo until approximately 3:00am the following morning. CV-3 told police she believed Gallo to have

drugged her by putting Molly in her drink. CV-3 stated once in high school she took Molly and was currently experiencing similar effects. CV-3 stated she believed she was on Molly because she could not stop her jaw from moving or grinding her teeth, and her eyes were big. CV-3 repeatedly stated she did not feel normal.

On June 18, 2024, Affiant Maialetti met with CV-3 at Bristol Township Police Headquarters for an interview. CV-3 reported that she met Gallo on a sugar daddy website where young girls meet older men and spend time with them in exchange for money. In their communications prior to meeting at his residence, Gallo told CV-3 that when she arrived he could make them a couple drinks, watch television together and she could keep him company while he packs for a trip. CV-3 stated she arrived at Gallo's residence around 10:30pm on February 22, 2024. CV-3 stated Gallo told her he is a really good bartender, asked if she wanted a drink and suggested margaritas. CV-3 watched Gallo make her drink in the kitchen. CV-3 stated the bottles Gallo used to pour the drinks were in the cabinets. CV-3 was unable to say with certainty if the bottles were new or previously opened. Gallo put a small crystal-like substance on a plate to dip the top of the drinking glasses. CV-3 reported the substance did not look like salt particles but like little crystal rocks that were a mixture between clear and yellow in color. CV-3 stated she does not drink often and has never had a margarita before, so she did not know what they are supposed to taste like. After Gallo made the drinks they began watching television in his bedroom. During the evening, CV-3 declined Gallo's sexual advances, including offers to try on lingerie, and he became mad at her. Gallo went into the bathroom and sent her a text message stating he ordered her an Uber for her to leave.

As she was standing outside, CV-3 started feeling strange as her body kept fidgeting and her jaw kept moving fast from side to side. CV-3 believed, due to how she was feeling, that Gallo drugged her and that he must have done it through her drink. Prior to meeting Gallo, CV-3 provided Gallo's address to her sister in case of an emergency. CV-3 advised her sister had subsequently called police for a well-being check because she was unable to get in contact with her. Bristol Township Police officers arrived on scene and requested emergency medical

personnel respond to the scene due to CV-3's physical state. CV-3 agreed to be seen by medics but refused transport to the hospital. CV-3 stated because of the substance(s) Gallo gave her, she was up for almost seven (7) days straight. CV-3 advised your Affiants that she did not knowingly ingest any narcotics while with Andrew Gallo at his residence in Bristol Township, nor did she consent to any narcotics being provided to her surreptitiously.

CV-4

Through interviews with your Affiants, CV-4 reported the following: CV-4 advised she met a man, identified as Andrew Gallo, on SugarDaddyMeet.com. On August 1, 2024, she entered into a text message conversation with Gallo, wherein the pair engaged in small talk across a few days. Gallo used phone number (267) 732-9753. On August 4, 2024, CV-4 traveled to Gallo's residence in Levittown via ride he acquired for her, arriving between 6:00pm and 7:00pm.

Upon her arrival, Gallo prepared them both a mixed alcoholic beverage, which CV-4 believed to contain tequila, syrup and either lemon or lime. CV-4 further believed the tequila was poured from an already-opened bottle. Gallo, who had recently returned home from work, went to shower. CV-4 had been given a tour of the home and was shown pictures of the home's rebuild, as Gallo told her of a previous fire at the residence. Gallo also showed CV-4 lingerie he kept in another room, claiming it was an ex-girlfriend's who never got to wear it. CV-4 later wore the lingerie at Gallo's request. Gallo offered CV-4 Molly, which she declined.

The pair remained at Gallo's residence, where they continued drinking. CV-4 recalled Gallo pouring shots of tequila into her mouth at points in the evening, but could not recall how much she drank. CV-4 stated that at some point before losing consciousness, she agreed to have sex with Gallo. CV-4 was unable to recall much of the evening, but was able to provide the following information: She recalled vomiting at one point during the night, which she believed was between 2:00 and 3:00am. CV-4 also recalled falling on more than one occasion, once from the bed and other times from standing. CV-4 recalled performing oral sex on Gallo. CV-4 also remembered Gallo choking her to unconsciousness more than once, stating that she would wake

up and recall him doing it again. CV-4 tried to fight him off, but was unable. She stated he appeared to be, "...enjoying..." it.

The next day, August 5, 2024, CV-4 woke up bruised and not feeling well. She reported staying in bed for the entirety of the day until Gallo returned home from work. Gallo was insistent that she drink more alcohol to the point that she relented and did a few more shots. On August 6, 2024, CV-4 realized she wanted to go home but needed a ride. She asked Gallo for a ride home, which he told her he would give, but never did. On August 7, 2024, CV-4 was able to convince Gallo to drive her home. Gallo drove her halfway, calling her an Uber from a McDonald's off the highway.

Shortly after returning home on August 7<sup>th</sup>, CV-4 was feeling both mentally and physically unwell. CV-4 went to Saint Luke's Hospital for evaluation. In addition to the bruising and feelings of mental distress, CV-4 reported a reddening/bruising of her mouth lining. CV-4's laboratory results indicated that she had amphetamine/methamphetamine metabolites in her system. CV-4 confronted Gallo via text, who told her that he had given her Adderall to ingest when they were together. CV-4 advised your Affiants that she did not knowingly ingest any narcotics while with Andrew Gallo at his residence in Bristol Township, nor did she consent to any narcotics being provided to her surreptitiously. Further, CV-4 did not recall being given nor ingesting any pills.

CV-4 confirmed she only consented to sex with Gallo after having ingested alcohol which he provided her. Further, CV-4 reported she did not consent to being choked at any point, nor did she want to be choked.

CV-5

On August 15, 2024, a search warrant was executed at Andrew Gallo's residence, 32 Copper Beech Lane in Bristol Township. Subsequent to making entry, law enforcement encountered CV-5 lying on the bed in Gallo's bedroom. CV-5 was spoken to by your Affiants, advised why law

enforcement was present and consented to a blood draw as a result CV-5 was transported to Lower Bucks Hospital, where two (2) vials of CV-5's blood were collected. The vials were subsequently secured and submitted for forensic analysis.

After the blood draw, CV-5 consented to an interview with police at Bristol Township Police Headquarters. During the interview, CV-5 reported she has been seeing Gallo since late November 2023, just after turning eighteen (18) years of age. CV-5 met Gallo on a Sugar Daddy dating site called sugardaddymeet.com. CV-5 has traveled to Gallo's house several times between November 2023 and August 15, 2024. The visits typically last longer than one (1) day and involve some form of sexual interaction. CV-5 advised during one (1) previous stay, she willingly ingested the narcotic Molly several times, which was provided to her by Gallo. Aside from that visit, CV-5 stated that she mostly ingested alcohol while at his house (also provided by Gallo) until the current visit. CV-5 arrived at Gallo's residence on Tuesday evening, August 13, 2024. The pair had sex during the visit. On the night of August 14 into August 15, Gallo provided CV-5 with triangular pills, one bluish and one red, which he offered as a version of male and female Viagra. In addition to these pills, Gallo mixed alcoholic drinks for both of them. CV-5 advised your Affiants that during this visit she did not knowingly ingest any narcotics while with Andrew Gallo at his residence in Bristol Township, nor did she consent to any narcotics being provided to her surreptitiously. CV-5 stated after ingesting the pills and the alcoholic beverage, CV-5 performed oral sex on Gallo. CV-5 stated that her stomach then started burning and she vomited several times. CV-5 stated that Gallo pressured her for sex, even after she was continuously throwing up. Per CV-5, Gallo was angry that they could not have sex because she did not feel good. The pair had just laid down to sleep when law enforcement executed the search warrant.

During the course of her interview CV-5 advised your Affiants that Gallo would choke her during sex, almost to the point of unconsciousness. She told your Affiants this was something she did not want to happen, and she would try to push him away during this action, but was unable to stop him.

CV-6

Through interviews with your Affiants, CV-6 reported the following: CV-6 met a man, whom she identified as Andrew John, age forty (40), on a Sugar Daddy dating site called sugardaddymeet.com. CV-6 provided Affiant Maialetti with a screenshot of Andrew's profile, username DREWSTER420, which lists him as a forty (40) year old male residing in Levittown, PA. CV-6 provided the profile picture for Andrew, which Affiant Maialetti identified as Andrew Gallo. CV-6 stated on her profile she listed her age as nineteen (19).

On Thursday August 8, 2024, at approximately 2000 hours (08:00 PM), CV-6 went to Gallo's residence, located at 32 Copper Beech Lane, Levittown, PA, 19055, to meet him for the first time. When she first arrived, Gallo had a drink pre-made and waiting for her. CV-6 described the drink as a margarita-type drink, as it had a salt rim. CV-6 tried a small sip of the drink but did not want to finish it due to it tasting very salty. CV-6 was reluctant to consume the drink because it was prepared prior to her arrival, and she did not want to consume it in fear of Gallo possibly spiking it.

When she arrived, and prior to them engaging in any sexual contact, CV-6 advised Gallo that she was seventeen (17) years old, not nineteen (19) as her profile had indicated. When she advised Gallo of her correct age he replied, "*You are going to receive a punishment then*". CV-6 advised Gallo then poured two shots of Mi Campo, a tequila that is light brown in color, directly from the bottle into her mouth. CV-6 stated the bottle was open prior to her arrival. CV-6 did not recall Gallo drinking from that bottle during their encounter. The two (2) left the residence for food and subsequently returned to engage in sexual contact.

During their sexual contact, Gallo poured approximately fifteen (15) more shots of Mi Campo into her mouth. CV-6 believed Gallo was trying to get her drunk all night. When she did not want to drink anymore, Gallo poured the alcohol on her vagina. CV-6 stated that there was a large amount of lingerie items in his residence, which Gallo indicated had belonged to an ex-

girlfriend. Gallo asked CV-6 to put the lingerie on, take videos of herself, and send the videos to him.

CV-6 reported that Gallo liked to have “...*really really really really rough sex*” and that he used sex toys on her. CV-6 advised Gallo also liked choking and slapping while engaging in sexual contact. Gallo also wanted her to regurgitate on his penis. CV-6 did not believe she lost consciousness, but stated she does not remember falling asleep. CV-6 stated the last thing she remembers is Gallo pouring tequila down her mouth and then waking up and the sun was out.

CV-6 stated Gallo went to work at approximately 1400 hours (2:00 PM) on August 9, 2024, leaving her alone in his residence. Gallo was supposed to be back from work at approximately 2300 hours (11:00 PM). While alone in Gallo’s residence, CV-6’s stomach began burning and she subsequently vomited. CV-6 stayed at his residence for a few hours but began to start feeling, “...*weird*”. CV-6 left his residence around 1800 hours (6:00 PM) and returned home. While at home, CV-6 began hallucinating and believed she was hearing what sounded like a dog barking, seeing things such as spiders, and feeling as though things were touching her. CV-6 stated she has consumed alcohol before and has felt the effects of a ‘hang over’ from alcohol consumption, but what she experienced that day were different than any other time she has consumed alcohol. CV-6 advised she had previously been prescribed Adderall but had not taken it in a significant amount of time. Due to these hallucinations, CV-6 decided to go to the hospital for treatment.

On August 10, 2024, CV-6 went to the Children’s Hospital of Pennsylvania (CHOP), in Philadelphia, PA for treatment, which included a forensic examination and laboratory tests. CV-6 provided a urine sample during the course of her forensic examination. The urine sample was placed in a sealed sexual assault evidence kit that was provided to police and secured in evidence for further forensic analysis. The kit was sent to NMS Labs for further testing. On September 6, 2024, NMS Labs issued a report under Case ID number 24-16239 that was provided to your

Affiants. This report indicated that CV-6’s urine, submitted on August 16, 2024, tested positive for methamphetamine, amphetamine, and THC.

Your Affiants subsequently obtained the medical records for CV-6 during her treatment at the CHOP. During the course of CV-6’s treatment at the Children’s Hospital of Pennsylvania (CHOP), she was given a urinalysis. The analysis indicated CV-6 tested positive for Cannabinoids, Amphetamine, and Methamphetamine.

**ANALYSIS OF ITEMS COLLECTED FROM GALLO RESIDENCE**

Several items were collected from Andrew Gallo’s residence, 32 Copper Beech Lane Levittown, PA 19055 during the execution of the search warrant on August 15, 2024. As of this filing, several of the collected items have been submitted for forensic analysis.

On September 6, 2024, NMS Labs issued a report under Case ID number 24-BUX-015721. This report indicated that a Casamigos Tequila bottle, submitted on August 23, 2024, tested positive for methamphetamine.

**CONCLUSION**

Your Honor, based on the facts contained herein, your Affiants respectfully request a warrant of arrest be issued for Andrew Gallo, D.O.B. 04/18/1984, for the following violations of the Pennsylvania Crimes Code:
