Your Affiant, Detective Jeffrey Jumper 9,9944, of the Bucks County Detectives/ Bucks County District Attorney's Office, has been duly sworn/ appointed/ employed as a Police Officer in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania since 2011. Your Affiant is certified as a Police Officer in Pennsylvania and is authorized to conduct criminal investigations and make arrests in . 211 criminal cases within Bucks County, Pennsylvania and is currently serving in the Gun Violence Task Force Unit (GVTF). "Throughout the course of my twelve (12) year career, I have investigated all facets of criminal activity, including, but not limited to, Criminal Homicide, Rape, Robbery, Aggravated Assault, and Firearm investigations..

Your Affiant is an "investigative or law enforcement officer" within the meaning of section 5702 of Pennsylvania Wiretapping and Electronic Surveillance Act and in, such capacity, your Affiant successfully completed wiretapping and electronic surveillance training as mandated in Section 5724 of Title 18 PA. C.S.A. As a result, your Affiant has received his class "A" certification (Certification Number A-6961) to monitor, utilize, maintain, and possess electronic surveillance equipment.

Your affiant; Special Agent Erie Frye, being duly sworn, deposes and says. I am a Special Agent employed by the Pennsylvania Office of the Attorney General in the Gun Violence Task Force. I investigate violations of the Pennsylvania Crimes Code including Violations of the Uniform Firearms Act. Prior to working with the Gun Violence Task Force, I was employed by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms (ATF) as a Special Agent from July 2001 until October 2012. During my time with ATF, I authored hundreds of search and arrest warrants, most notably in the area of firearms trafficking and straw purchasing.

The facts set forth in this affidavit are based upon your Affiant's personal knowledge; knowledge obtained from other individuals/entities during my participation in his investigation, including other law enforcement personnel; review of documents and records related to this investigation; communications with others who have personal

knowledge of the events and circumstances described herein; as well as information gained through my training and experience..

Because this affidavit is being prepared for the sole purpose of establishing probable cause, not every fact nor detail of the below investigation has been incorporated into same.



When a person wants to purchase a handgun within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, they must meet the following requirements: be twenty-one (21) years of age or older, present some form of state identification, and pass an instant background check referred to as a Pennsylvania Instant Check System (PICS). The PICS check ensures the prospective buyer is not precluded by law from owning a handgun.

Next, the Federal Firearm License (FFL) dealers are required by law to complete two (2) and, if applicable, three (3) different forms. The first form is the Pennsylvania State Police, Application/Record of Sale (SP-4-113). This form documents the purchaser's name, date of birth, age, gender, race, height, weight, address, Pennsylvania ID number and employer information, which the buyer supplies the information. There are four (4) "yes or no" questions the buyer must answer and two (2) separate signature lines. This form also documents the FFL dealer, employee's, and handgun information.

Another required form is the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) form (ATF Form 4473). "Section A" of this form details the buyer's name, current address, place of birth, height, weight, gender, date of birth, ethnicity, and race. There are several "yes or no" questions, including those about the buyer's competency, criminal history, drug use, immigration status, and history with domestic violence that the buyer must answer and a signature line. The purchaser attests that he or she is not a prohibited person and is the actual buyer/transferee. "Section 13" of this form is completed by the FFL dealer that notes the type of firearm, the identification presented by the buyer, the date of purchase and other transactional information. "Section C" of this form documents the firearm information, such as the manufacturer, model, serial number, type and caliber/gauge of the firearm. The completed and signed ATF Form 4473 serves as the authorization for the FFL to initiate a firearm's eligibility check through the National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS).

In the event of a person intending to purchase multiple firearms at the same time, the FFL dealer must complete a U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) form named Report of Multiple Sale or Other Disposition of Pistols and Revolvers, (ATF Form 3310.4). The FFL dealer documents the type, serial number, manufacturer, model, importer, caliber, and transfer date of all the firearms purchased by the buyer.

If a private citizen wants to sell a handgun to another private citizen, both the transferor and the transferee must complete both the ATF 4473 form and the

SP4-11= form, and both must pass a background check. Transfers of long guns (those with lengths exceeding those set forth -- n the definition of "firearm" in 18 Pa.C.S. b 102) involving an FFL (either as buyer or seller, or as intermediary) are still subject to a background check, and the ATF 4-473 form must still be completed by the transferor and transferee, but the SP 4-113 does not. On the other hand. private citizens not engaged "in the business" of firearm sales may buy/se-11/trade long guns among each other as long as they are not prohibited under state or federal law.



A "straw purchase" is an illegal firearms transaction that occurs when the actual buyer of a firearm uses another person, a "straw purchaser," as an intermediary to execute the required paperwork to purchase a firearm from a federally licensed firearms dealer (FFL). A "straw purchaser" is a person with a clean criminal background who purchases firearms specifically on behalf of a person to conceal the true ownership of the firearm. The true owner of the firearm is commonly prohibited from purchasing a firearm because he or she is a convicted felon, domestic violence misdemeanor, juvenile, mentally ill individual, or other person prohibited under federal or state law.

THE TARGET OF THIS INVESTIGATION

Jawone WILLIAMS, the target of the investigation, reportedly resides at 2123 Moore Street, Philadelphia, PA 19145. WILLIAMS is a black male approximately 5'11" tall. WILLIAMS' date of birth is July 1, 1992. Law Enforcement databases indicate WILLIAMS lists 2123 Moore Street, Philadelphia, PA 19145 as his residence. On every firearm purchase form (ATF 473/SP 4-113), WILLIAMS lists 2123 Moore Street, Philadelphia, PA 19145 as his residence. In speaking with WILLIAMS, via phone, he has confirmed his address to be 2123 Moore Street, Philadelphia, PA 19145.

A search of the Pennsylvania State Police Central Repository showed that Jawone WILLIAMS has no criminal history. WILLIAMS is legally allowed to purchase firearms in Pennsylvania.

WILLIAMS has purchased twenty (20) firearms from various Federal Firearm Licensed dealers (FFL'S) in Bucks County, Montgomery County, Philadelphia County, Delaware County, Lehigh County between the dates of 7/14/2019 and 5/22/2022. Of the twenty (20) firearms purchased by WILLIAMS, thirteen (13) were purchased in Bucks County, PA; (10) ten from Johnston's Sporting Goods, 715 State Road, Croydon, PA 19021, two (2) from MEGA Pawn, 334-336 W. Bridge Street, Morrisville, PA 19067, and one (1) from Classic Pistol, 1310 Industrial Boulevard, Southampton, PA 18966.

On October 17, 2023, a report was generated on WILLIAMS by Detective Jumper which initially revealed six (6) of the twenty (20) firearms purchased by WILLIAMS to have been recovered by law enforcement. Based upon the discovery of the recovered firearms made by police and other criminal indicators, Detective Jumper opened an investigation into the suspected "straw purchase" of firearms committed by Jawone WILLIAMS.

On February 8, 2024, Detective Jumper was contacted by Pennsylvania Office of

the Attorney General, S.A. Eric Frye, regarding another firearm recovery belonging to WILLIAMS that had been recovered by the Ashland Borough Police Department, 401 South 18th Street, Ashland, PA 17921, on January 31, 2024. This discovery brought the current total number of recoveries to nine (9).



and convenience, have cited the events and actions that occurred during this investigation as incidents . Included within the incidents are the dates and locations of the firearm purchases, as well as the circumstances surrounding the nine (9) recovered firearms. The firearm purchase information was determined after reviewing the State and Federal records from each Federally Licensed Firearm Dealer. To date, none of the twenty firearms purchased by WILLIAMS have been reported stolen or transferred.

INCIDENT NUMBER ONE — JULY 14, 2019

On July 14, 2019, Jawone WILLIAMS purchased the following handgun at Double Action. located at 611 Industrial Park, Yeadon, PA 19050, Delaware County.

1. Sig Sauer Model P320, 40ea1, semi-automatic pistol with Serial Number 58A040936.

Jawone Williams indicated, on the Application/Record of Sale, that he purchased the firearm for himself and not another individual.

FIREARM RECOVERY -- FEBRUARY 7, 2022

Time To Crime (TTC): 940 Days

On February 7, 2022, the Philadelphia Police Department arrested I.M. for violations of the Uniform Firearms Act (VLTFA). Phila. PD initiated a stop on a vehicle, R.M. exited the rear passenger side with a black firearm in his right hand. Philadelphia Police Officer Kology chased R.M. in the park with the firearm still in his right hand. Ofc. Kology observed R.M. discard the black firearm in a wooded area of the park. After apprehending R.M., Ofc. Kology went back to where he observed R.M. discard the firearm and recovered a black Sig Sauer .40 serial ff58A040936.

Jawone Williams indicated, on the Application/Record of Sale, that he purchased the firearm for himself and not another individual.

FIREARM RECOVERY — JULY 6, 2021

TTC: 13 Days

On July 6, 2021, Philadelphia Police Officer 's observed a 2010 Gre• Honda Accord with RA, Temp Tag : 3501-097 with an expiration date of 7-2-21, parked outside of residence 2847 Amber St, with the engine running, dark tinted windows, and unoccupied. ?olice were able to determine the PA Temp tag was fraudulent due to the letter "P" being capitalized where it should have been



lowercase. Police recorded the VIN: I HGCP3F88AA002888 and relayed the

information to the district operations room personnel who determined the vehicle was stolen status in NCIC/PCIC under OCA: 3021001543 out of Wilmington, DE. Police then opened the door to process the vehicle and recovered a black 9mm Glock 17 Gen 5 serial number BFKT111, with (18) live rounds including one in the chamber on top of the driver's seat.

A significant factor when determining whether an individual is conducting straw purchases, your Affiants must consider the time the firearm was purchased in relation to when the firearm was recovered. In this instance, WILLIAMS purchased the Glock model 17, on June 24, 2021. Thirteen days later, on July 6, 2021, the Glock model 17 was recovered by law enforcement inside a stolen vehicle.

INCIDENT NUMBER THREE- JUNE 26, 2021

On June 26, 2021, Jawone WILLIAMS purchased the following handgun at E.F. Precision: 230= Computer Ave., Willow Grove PA 19090, Montgomery County, through a private party transfer, acquired from Nichola Walker.

WILLIAMS indicated, on the Application/Record of Sale, that he purchased the firearm for himself and not another individual.

INCIDENT NUMBER FOUR — JUNE 27, 2021

On June 27, 2021, at approximately 1311 hours, Jawone WILLIAMS purchased the following handgun at Johnstons Sporting Goods LLC., 715 State Road, Croydon PA 19021, Bucks County, through a private party transfer, acquired from Ronald Schatz.

4. Glock Model 23 Gen 4, .40 Cal, semi-automatic pistol with Serial Number BKLA437.

Jawone WILLIAMS indicated, on the Application/Record of Sale, that he purchased the firearm for himself and not another individual. WILLIAMS listed his occupation as a security officer with Securitas.

On June 28, 2021, at approximately 1409 hours, Jawone WILLIAMS purchased the following handgun at Johnstons Sporting Goods LLC., 715 State Road, Croydon PA 19021, Bucks County.

Jawone WILLIAMS indicated, on the Application/Record of Sale, that he purchased the firearm for himself and not another individual. WILLIAMS listed his

Jawone WILLIAMS indicated, on the Application/Record of Sale, that he purchased the firearm for himself and not another individual. Williams listed his occupation as a security with Securitas.

FIREARM RECOVERY -- October 20, 2022

TTC: 470 Days

On October 20, 2022, members of the Philadelphia Swat Team executed a search on several residences within Philadelphia. At approximately 0615 hours, Philadelphia Swat conducted a search on a residence located at 3152 Weymouth Street, Philadelphia, P.A. The search resulted in the recovery of a black leather style bag containing (1) loaded Glock bearing serial number HUL589, (1) loaded Glock 23 bearing serial number BSRF744 with a 40-caliber magazine loaded with (45) rounds of ammunition, (1) Ruger 9mm, (1) Taurus 38 caliber bearing serial number AAL061522, and a box of 380 caliber ammunition. Police recovered \$ 124,211 USC, blue pills, suspected fentanyl, and a blue glassine baggie stamped with "DEBO" containing a white substance of suspected heroin. Jawone WILLIAMS indicated, on the Application/Record of Sale, that he purchased the firearm for himself and not another individual.

FIREARM RECOVERY —January 31, 2024



Ashland Police Department was dispatched to Red White and Blue Auto for the report of a firearm that was found in a vehicle. The complainant stated that they purchased the vehicle from the Manheim Auction on 10/17/2023. While they were detailing the vehicle, they located a gun under the seat. The Ashland PD took custody of the firearm, a Ruger model 57, bearing serial number 643-17529.

it should be noted over the course of sixty-four (64) days, WILLIAMS purchased nine (9) firearms, four (4) of which were the exact same make and model firearm, a Ruger Model 57 and five (5) Glocks were purchased by WILLIAMS, three (3) .40cal and two (2) 9mm models.

Jawone WILLIAMS indicated, on the Application/Record of Sale, that he purchased the frearm for himself and not another individual. WILLIAMS listed his occupation as a security guard with Securitas. Mr. Williams provided the F L (Phila. Training Academy) with his PA Driver's License, social security card, and a debit card with his name on it.

INCIDENT NUMBER ELEVEN —NOVEMBER 4, 2021.

On November 4, 2021, at approximately 1408 hours, Jawone Williams purchased the following handgun at Johnstons Sporting Goods LLC., 715 State Road, Croydon PA 19021, Bucks County.

Jawone WILLIAMS indicated, on the Application/Record of Sale, that he purchased the firearm for himself and not another individual. Williams did not list an employer or occupation.



TTC: 161: Days

On April 14, 2022, at approximately 5:25 pm, Philadelphia Police Officers responded to the area of 3400 North Braddock Street for the report of a shooting. Upon their arrival, they located a which consisted of several damaged vehicles as a result of a car acc_de.it, ten (10) 9mm fired cartridge casings (FCC), a .45 caliber Glock handgun, and a black 223 assault rifle. As pclice were approaching the crime scene, they were flagged down by a pedestrian who stated that there were three males in the alleyway between the houses on the 3300 hundred block of Braddock Street. Officer approached the alleyway and located three males. One of the males, later identified as G.R., was suffering from a single gunshot wound to the left shoulder and. back. He was transported to Temple ER and treated for his injuries.

The other two males were identified as M.R. and T.H. A search of the : mmediate area by =he Officers revealed a Black .45 caliber Glock handgun, serial number D VAY138 with an empty magazine. The firearm was swabbed for DNA and placed on the property receipt.

INCIDENT NUMBER TWELVE — NOVEMBER 15, 2021

On December 11, 2021, at approximately 1232 hours, Jawone WILLIAMS purchased the following handgun at Johnstons Sporting Goods LLC., 715 State Road, Croydon PA. 19021, Bucks County.

15. Glock Model 33,357, semi-automatic pistol with Serial Number FWK625.

Jawone WILLIAMS indicated, on the Application/Record of Sale, that he purchased the firearm for himself and not another individual.

INCIDENT NUMBER FIFTEEN -- JANUARY 20, 2022

On January 20, 2022, at approximately 1416 hours, Jawone WILLIAMS purchased the following handgun at Johnstons Sporting Goods LLC., 715 State Road, Croydon PA 19021, Bucks County.

16. Glock Model 20SF, 10mm, semi-automatic pistol with Serial Number BVXX867.

Jawone WILLIAMS indicated, on the Application/Record of Sale, that he purchased the firearm for himself and not another individual. Williams did not list an employer or occupation on the SP 4-113 form.

INCIDENT NUMBER SIXTEEN — FEBRUARY 5, 2022

On February 5, 2022, at approximately 1610 hours, Jawone WILLIAMS purchased the following handgun at MEGA PAWN, 336 W. Bridge, Morrisville PA 19067, Bucks County.

17. Glock Model 19 Gen 3, 9mm, semi-automatic pistol with Serial Number AFYK061.

Jawone WILLIAMS indicated, on the Application/Record of Sale, that he purchased the firearm for himself and not another individual. Williams listed his occupation as a security officer with Allied Security.

FIREARM RECOVERY — DECEMBER 20, 2022

TTC: 318 days

On December 18, 2022, Philadelphia Police Department (PPD) responded to the area on N Hutchinson Street for the report of a shooting. Upon arrival, officers located a crime scene on the highway of 800 W. Tioga Street consisting of six (6) 9mm FCCs and a black 2010 Chrysler Town & Country minivan that appeared to have been struck multiple times by gunfire. A short time later, officers learned of a 36-year-old male that had arrived at Temple Hospital suffering from multiple gunshot wounds to the back. On December 20, 2022, the Philadelphia Police Department arrested J.P. for violations of the Uniform Firearms Act (VUFA). A search of J.P.'s residence resulted in the recovery of a Glock Model 19 bearing

serial number AFYK06I loaded with twenty (20) live 9mm rounds and was equipped with a laser sight attachment. Two handguns, a rifle, ballistic vest, and ammunition were recovered from the residence. In an



interview, E.P. admitted to owning the guns found inside the home and to

buying them on the Street.

INCIDENT NUMBER SEVENTEEN — FEBRUARY 15, 2022

On February 15, 2022, at approximately 1534 hours, Jawone WILLIAMS purchased the following handgun at Johnstons Sporting Goods LLC., 715 State Road, Croydon.PA 19021, Bucks County.

1.8. Glock Model 19, 9mm, semi-automatic pistol with Serial Number BVTK869.

Jawone WILLIAMS indicated, on the Application/Record of Sale, tha-- he purchased the firearm for himself and not another individual. Williams did not list an employer or occupation on the SP 4-113 form.

FIREARM RECOVERY -- NOVEMBER 27, 2022

TTC: 284 days

On 11/27/2022, Philadelphia Police arrested E.R. for VUFA at 2430 Castor Ave Phila, PA. A search of E.R.'s vehicles resulted in the recovery of a . 9mm Glock, wish an obliterated serial # (766.22-002237), a . 9mm Glock, model 19, bearing serial #BVTK869 and a.40 cal Glock, model 22, bearing serial #WPM428. A NIBIN trace report was generated which linked WILLIAMS firearm, Glock 19, bearing serial number BVTK869 to a shooting that occurred in Philadelphia on 11/6/2022, no injuries were reported.

INCIDENT NUMBER EIGHTEEN — MARCH 24, 2022

On March 24, 2022, at approximately 1319 hours,. Jawone WILLIAMS purchased the following handgun at Johnstons Sporting Goods LLC., 71.5 State Road, Croydon PA 19021, Bucks County.

19. Glock Model 20, 10mm, semi-automatic pistol with Serial Number . BWMS533.

Jawone WILLIAMS indicated, on the Application/Record of Sale, that he purchased the firearm for himself and not another individual.

FIREARM RECOVERY -- MAY 1, 2022

TTC: 39 Days

On May 1, 2022, the Upper Darby Township Police Department arrested E.A. for receiving stolen property, carrying a firearm w/o a license, and prohibited offensive weapons. During the execution of a search warrant on E.A.'s vehicle, a Glock bearing serial numberBWMS533 was recovered. from his vehicle.

INCIDENT NUMBER NINETEEN -- MAY 22, 2022

On May 22, 2022, at approximately 1319 hours, Jawone WILLIAMS purchased

the following handgun at Classic Pistol, 1310 Industrial Boulevard, Southampton, PA 18966, Bucks County, through a private party transfer, acquired from Kyle Weidner.



GHZ289. Jawone WILLIAMS indicated, on the Application/Record of Sale, that he purchased the firearm for himself and not another individual.

On January 4, 2024, Detective Jumper attempted to speak with WILLIAMS at his address at 2123 Moore Street, Philadelphia, PA. WILLIAMS was not home at the time of the visit, however a relative was able to provide Detective Jumper with a contact number for which he could be reached. WILLIAMS was contacted, via phone, shortly thereafter. WILLIAMS confirmed his identity and stated that he was currently at work and unable to talk. When asked if Williams lived at the 733 N 43rd Street address, WILLIAMS stated he lived at his aunt's house at 2123 Moore Street. Detective Jumper asked Williams if he owned any firearms to which he stated he did. Detective Jumper scheduled a meeting with WILLIAMS for a later date, which he never showed up for.

Through investigation YourAffant identified Jawone William's cousin, Shereef Gray. Mr Gray was arrested on August 22, 2022, and pleaded guilty to 6111 G4ii (F3) and 61110 1. Mr. Gray admitted to buying the handgun for his cousin, Tyshan Franklin, which is a straw purchase. Mr. Gray resides at the same address as Mr. Williams.

Over the course of the next several months, several in person and virtual meetings were scheduled with WILLIAMS, however on the dates of all the scheduled meetings, WILLIAMS failed to appear.

On February 19, 2024, your Affiant looked through Record of Sale and ATF 4473 forms and attempted to search for any phone numbers that were provided by WILLIAMS during the time at which the firearm was purchased. Two transactions were located where WILLIAMS had provided the phone number, (267) 257-6843, to the FFL dealer. Pursuant to a search warrant, cellular phone records for the phone number (267) 257-6843 were provided by T Mobile and an analysis was conducted. Due to record retention periods stretching beyond T Mobile's date range, only two of the twenty purchases made by WILLIAMS were captured. The two dates on which WILLIAMS purchased firearms, 3/24/22 and 5/22/22, were analyzed using the location data provided by T Mobile: The locations in conjunction with the times of purchase put the cellular device within the area of Classic Pistol (Southampton, PA) and Johnston Sporting Goods (Croydon, PA).

On March 25, 2024, Detective Jumper spoke with WILLIAMS, via phone, who stated that he was at work at the moment and was unable to speak. Your Affiant asked WILLIAMS if he was working for the employer, MAXIM. WILLIAMS confirmed stating, "yes." Detective Jumper asked WILLIAMS if he had a chance

to look for the firearm that we spoke about. WILLIAMS replied, "yea, I'll be able to answer that once I'm off" WILLIAMS alluded to the fact that he was unable to answer any questions because he was inside a patient's home.



an employee, with their company but hadn't worked a shift after November 1, 2023. Per employee records, WILLIAMS listed the phone number (609) 418-3616 as his contact number. Through the course of the investigation, WILLIAMS appears to have been utilizing three different phone numbers. The phone number (267) 257-6843 was provided by WILLIAMS on the ATF 4473 forms. The phone number (267) 366-9664 was provided by a relative of WILLIAMS and used as the primary number to communicate with him. The phone number (609) 418-3616 was provided by his former employer, MAXIM Health Services, as the contact number listed in his employee record.

Detective Jumper contacted the sellers/transferors associated with the handgun sales involving WILLIAMS. Out of the five (5) sellers that your Affiant contacted, each one reportedly sold their handguns through the website Armslist.com. One seller was able to locate the email associated with the transaction and provided your Affiant with the buyer's email address: iaavoiiewilliams@icloud.com. The same seller also provided your Affiant with the buyer's phone number, (267) 257-6843 which he used in conjunction with the email address to communicate with WILLIAMS.

On May 13, 2024, subsequent to a search warrant, Armslist.com provided your Affiant's with subscriber information associated with the account user name "Wone" with the registered email address, jawonewilliams@icloud.com. Billing information provided, listed the name, Jawone Williams, with the address of 212 Moore Street, Philadelphia, PA : 1914-5.

In conjunction with the subscriber/billing information received, messaging history was also provided. From 6/24/2021 through 5/21/2022, WILLIAMS messaged approximately 11.0 sellers through the Armslist website inquiring if the handguns posted were still available for purchase. In reviewing the messaging history, WILLIAMS would make up to seven inquiries a day to different sellers checking the availability of firearms. Armslist records indicate WILLIAMS account was created on 6/24/2021, following the creation of the account WILLIAMS messaged a seller stating; "Hey I'm interested in buying this A.S SIP please link if you still have it." On 11/11/2021 user "alone" messaged user "litrunk69" asking if a firearm was still available. "litrunk 69" responded, " Only looking for trade really I don't have a tech to get it unless something catches my eye." User "Wane" replied, "oh ok only thing I have at the moment is a C: p]Oc." On 1/15/2022, user "Wone" would again message user "litrunk69" stating, "looking to buy asap." It should be noted that WILLIAMS purchased twelve handguns prior to contacting user "litrunk69" and was still the registered owner of said handguns. WILLIAMS LIA would repeatedly message sellers indicating that he needed the handguns ASAP and

would often try to negotiate for a lower price.

In summary, when investigating potential straw purchasers, your Affiant's must consider several indicators when deciding whether to pursue an investigation. Based on your Affiant's training and experience, WILLIAMS displayed several indicators of a straw purchaser. One indicator considered was based upon the acquisition of numerous firearms within a short period of time. WILLIAMS purchased a total of twenty (20) firearms with nineteen (19) of the firearms being



purchased between June. 2021 and Marcli 2022 (273 days) , Another factor your Affrant's rr t. consider is the number of recovered firearms

, in this case, nine (9) firearms of the twenty (20) firearms purchased by WILLIAMS were recovered. In reviewing the police reports associated with the recoveries, every firearm recovered was outside the possession/control of WILLIAMS.

In the totality of the above straw purchase indicators and circumstances, Supervising Special Agent Christopher Marnna of the Pennsylvania Office of the Attorney General Gun Violence Task Force can conclude and would offer an expert opinion that anyone who purchases firearms with the specific intent to illegally transfer those guns to other persons.

Your Honor, based on the facts set forth, Your Affiant respectfully requests a warrant be issued for the defendant to answer to the aforementioned charges.

We, Detective Jeffrey Jumper 49944 and Special agent Eric Frye, being duly sworn to law, depose and say that the facts set forth in the foregoing affidavit are true and correct to the best of our knowledge, information, and belief.
