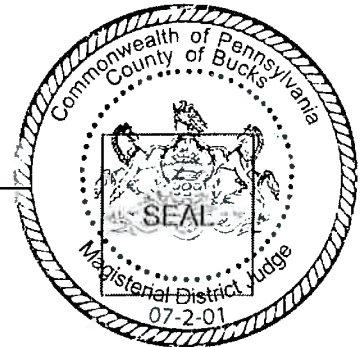

**AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE**

Your Affiant, Detective Ryan Jumper is a Sworn Northampton Township Police Officer, acting in such capacity since August, 2008 and is certified by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to conduct criminal investigations and effect arrests for violations of the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Your Affiant has been assigned to the Detective Division of the department since September of 2023. During my tenure as a criminal investigative detective, Your Affiant has been involved in numerous investigations and subsequent successful prosecutions of persons charged with violations of the Pennsylvania Crimes Code.

Your Affiant, Detective Jeffrey Jumper #9944, of the Bucks County Detectives/ Bucks County District Attorney's Office, has been duly sworn/ appointed/ employed as a Police Officer in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania since 2011. Your Affiant is certified as a Police Officer in Pennsylvania and is authorized to conduct criminal investigations and make arrests in all criminal cases within Bucks County, Pennsylvania. Through the course of my fourteen (14) year career, I have investigated all facets of criminal activity, including, but not limited to, Criminal Homicide, Rape, Robbery, Aggravated Assault, and firearm investigations.

Your Affiant, Detective Ronald MacPherson, badge #9946, of the Bucks County District Attorney's Office, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, has been duly sworn/appointed/employed as a police officer in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania since 2014. Your Affiant is certified as a police officer in Pennsylvania and is authorized to conduct criminal investigations and make arrests in all criminal cases within Bucks County, Pennsylvania.

The facts set forth in this affidavit are based upon your Affiants' personal knowledge; knowledge obtained from other individuals/entities during our participation in this investigation, including other law enforcement personnel; review of documents and records related to this investigation; communications with others who have personal knowledge of the events and circumstances described herein; as well as information gained through our training and experience.

On January 26, 2026, the Northampton Township police were dispatched to 26 Heather Road for the report of a well being check. The complainant, Steven Keczely called police to report that he had not heard from his girlfriend, Deborah Castiglia since Saturday, January 24, 2026. He advised that he was then unable to get in touch with Deborah. Keczely advised that on Sunday January 25, 2026, he went to his girlfriend's residence in Doylestown; however, when he checked for her there, neither she nor her vehicle was there.

Keczely said that on Sunday, January 25, 2026, he then drove to Deborah's parent's residence at 26 Heather Road, Churchville, PA 18966 around 6:30 p.m. and he observed Deborah's vehicle, a Maroon Kia Sportage displaying PA reg. JLV5720 in the driveway. Keczely stated that he did not observe any footprints in the snow leading up to the front door. Keczely said that he banged on the door numerous times. He said that there was no answer and the lights were off at that time. He subsequently left without making any contact with anyone at the residence.

Keczely said that on Monday, January 26, 2026, at approximately 2:15 p.m. he went back to 26 Heather Road and knocked numerous times on the door again. He said this time Deborah's brother whom he identified as "Kevin" came to the front door, dressed in a robe. Keczely said that he told Kevin that he wanted to talk to Debbie. Kevin replied that she was not there and that she probably went on vacation.

**AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE CONTINUATION**

Keczely stated he was a few feet from the door when Kevin approached. Kevin opened the door with a knife in hand and threatened Keczely stating, "don't ever come here again or I will kill you." Once Keczely observed the knife, he immediately jumped off the front porch and retreated to his vehicle. Keczely described the knife as a large "psycho" type Chef's knife. Keczely said that he retreated to his vehicle and drove down the block before he called 911 to report a well being check on his girlfriend and the threats made towards him by Kevin.

Northampton Township Police subsequently responded to this well being check at 26 Heather Road, the residence of Fred and Judith Castiglia. Prior contacts at the residence have also been with a Kevin Castiglia, 55 years of age.

Upon police knocking at the front door, there was no response. Northampton Police H.Q. attempted to call inside on the number that was in the records management system, with no answer. Police started to hail for Kevin to come to the door. Kevin Castiglia subsequently opened the front door. He was wearing a robe and was armed with two knives. Officer Michael Golembieski said that he believed one of the two knives had blood on it. When verbally contacted by officers at the front door, Kevin started talking incoherently. When asked about his family, Kevin did not reply. Kevin subsequently pointed knives at officers, at which time Officers Andrew Moffett and Sergeant Richard Mahony deployed their TASER, which is a less lethal device, in an attempt to disarm and control Kevin. The TASER did not achieve the desired effect and Kevin started pulling the TASER probes out of his body. Kevin then slammed the door and locked same.

Officers continued to attempt to talk to Kevin through the door but subsequently heard "stomping" around in the residence, as if someone had possibly went to the second floor. Due to the nature of the call along with no contact with any of the family members and Kevin being armed with knives, one possibly having blood on it, a tactical team was contacted in order to force entry into the residence to check the well being of the other persons believed to be present.

The South Central Emergency Response Team responded and subsequently made entry into the residence. Tactical Team personnel subsequently advised that they encountered one deceased female, believed to be Deborah Castiglia, located in the kitchen of the residence. Team personnel advised shortly thereafter that they encountered a deceased male and female, believed to be Frederick and Judith Castiglia, in the main level, rear bedroom of the residence. Upon checking for any other persons in the residence, they encountered Kevin Castiglia, armed with knives. The Tactical Team attempted to take Castiglia into custody through the use of less lethal weapons. However, he retreated into a second floor bedroom and barricaded himself in there, refusing to listen to commands.

After approximately five (5) hours, the suspect, Kevin Castiglia was taken into custody and transported to the local hospital. While receiving treatment at the hospital, Kevin told the doctor, "I hurt someone." About 2 hours later, Kevin made a statement toward hospital staff stating "I killed my parents in their sleep" and then went on to say, "I killed my sister when she found them."

After being cleared from Saint Mary Medical Center, Kevin was transported back to our HQ to be processed and arraigned. While at HQ, Kevin was brought into an interview room and provided his Miranda Warnings. Kevin agreed to speak with your Affiants. Kevin subsequently confessed to stabbing Fred Castiglia, Judith Castiglia and Deborah Castiglia to death.

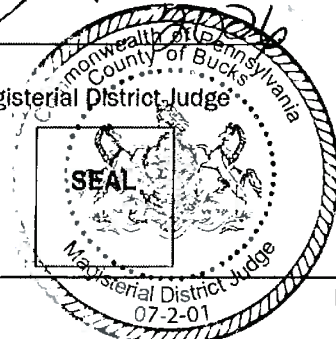
